Graduated from the University of Campania "L. Vanvitelli", Naples, on October 21st, 1976, magna cum laude. Graduated magna cum laude from the Postgraduate School of Internal Medicine.

Internal student, assistant, Full Professor of Gastroenterology of the Medical School. Director of the Master on Food, nutrition and health. Director of the postgraduated school of Gastroenterology and Digestive Endoscopy at University of Campania "L. Vanvitelli". Director of the National College of Gastroenterology's Teachers (UNIGASTRO). Member of the Italian Association for the Study of the Liver (AISF), of the Italian Society of Gastroenterology (SIGE), of the Italian Society of Alcoholology (SIA), of the International Society for Free Radical Research (SFRR). Activity of reviewer for main journals (Hepatology, J Hepatol, Dig Liver Dis, J Nutr, Eur J Gastroenterol, etc...). Main areas of scientific activity: a) the role of free radical species in the gastrointestinal tract and in liver disease; b) the relationships between liver damage and nutritional status; c) the role of alcohol in the induction and progression of liver damage. She is author of 156 papers, 42 chapters of books (two with invitation and for three books prof. Loguercio is also co-editor), 19 monographies and more than 300 national and international communications.
