

Pr. Elio Coppola graduated with a Degree in Agricultural Sciences - Crop Production, in 1990; in 1994 got a Ph.D. in Pedology and Agricultural Chemistry at the University of Naples "Federico II". During his Ph. D. course, he was visiting researcher at the EUF-BodenLabor in Rain am Lech (Germany), to acquire the Electro-UltraFiltration technique. Since 1994 he has been a Researcher, and from 1997, Confirmed Researcher in Agricultural Chemistry at the University of Basilicata. Since 2000 is permanent state teacher as Confirmed Researcher in Pedology at the Second University of Naples. Since 2010 is associate professor of soil science at the same university. Since 1998 Pr. Elio Coppola has been instructor of "Soil Chemistry" and "Soil Fertility and Plant Nutrition" at the University of Basilicata, "Geopedology" and "Applied Pedology II" at the Second University of Naples (actually University of Campania "Luigi Vanvitelli"), and instructor of "Elements of pedology", "Techniques for soil rehabilitation and conservation", and "Evaluation of Environmental Impact" in post-degree courses.

The main research fields of Pr. Elio Coppola are the General and Applied Pedology, the Chemistry, of Soil, and the Soil Fertility and Plant Nutrition, with special reference to: a) the characterization of soils in mediterranean environment; b) the strategies of rehabilitation of degraded soils by natural and recycle inorganic and organic materials; c) the testing and application of innovative methods for the assessment of dynamics and availability of macro-, meso-, and micronutrients in soil/plant systems; d) the elaboration and application of low-impact models for the sustainable management of agricultural and forest resources. Pr. Elio Coppola co-operated in several CNR-RAISA, MURST, PANDA, LIFE research programs, and is member of International Society of Soil Sciences (I.S.S.S.), European Society for Soil Conservation (E.S.S.C.); Società Italiana di Scienza del Suolo (S.I.S.S.); Associazione Italiana Zeoliti (A.I.Z.); Società Italiana di Pedologia (Si.P.E.). In 1990/2018 Pr. Elio Coppola published 146 in extenso papers on national and international journals or congress proceedings, and contributed with 215 oral or poster communications to national or international conferences.
