Michele Fabrazzo was born in Pozzuoli (Na) on february 13, 1956. He is research assistant at the University of Naples - SUN. At the Second University of Naples he graduated in Psychiatry and he took a Ph.D. in Pharmacology at Georgetown University, Washington, D.C. (USA).

He teaches Neuropsychopharmacology and Psychiatry in several Courses at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli” and for residents in Psychiatry and Neurology.

Since 1994 he is member of the Advisor Board of Bollettino Scientifico di Psicofarmacologia, member of the Italian Society of Psychiatry and of the Italian Society of Neuroscience.

From June 1986 to December 1990, he has done research in the field of Neuroscience and Neuropharmacology at the Fidia-Georgetown Institute for the Neurosciences in Washington, D.C. – USA. as “research assistant”.

His main research interests are trophic factors, psychopharmacology of antidepressants and of antipsychotics and their correlation to clinical symptomatology, neuroimmunoendocrinology of psychosis and of eating disorders.
