
## Prof. Rosario Serpico

## Clinical Activity

Ever since the beginning of his career he has always been dedicated to Pathology and Oral Medicine. Between 1992 and 1997, he played clinical activity as University Researcher at the "University of the Studies of Naples Federico II" and then at the "Second University of Naples". He activated in 1997, in Bari, the Module of "Diagnosis of Cure and Prevention of Oral Mucosal Pathologies", conducting clinical activity until February 2006, with primary duties at the "Dental Clinic of the Bari Hospital". He is currently Director of the Oral Mucosa Pathology Program and Primary doctor of the Special Odontostomatological Pathology Unit in the Multidisciplinary Department of medical-surgical and dental specialties in oral medicine and odontostomatologic diseases at the "University of Campania - Luigi Vanvitelli" for the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of oral mucosa diseases, such as: oral aftosis, oral candidiasis, erythema multiforme, lupus, pemphigo, pemphigoid, systemic sclerosis, Sjögren's syndrome, BMS, herpetic stomatitis, allergic stomatitis, oral precancerosis (leukoplakia, erythropathy), benign and malignant neoplasms of the oral cavity (oral squamous carcinoma) and oral manifestations of systemic pathologies. Head of the Reference Center for Oral Cancer Diagnosis and Therapy (ANDI) and the Reference Center for Oral Cancer Clinical Diagnosis. (FNOMCeO-CAO).
