Professional esperience

During his career Prof. Napolitano has been particularly interested in gastrointestinal pathology, specially as regard to the esophagus, the stomach and the colon. The study group which he has worked with, dedicated most part of its activity to the pathophisiology of the esophagus. Most part of his surgical activity has been likewise dedicated to the treatment of gastrointestinal diseases and he achieved a good experience both with laparotomic and laparoscopic approach.

Even since the beginning of his career Prof. Napolitano has been also particularly interested in endoscopic techniques, both diagnostic and therapeutic that he has been practicing since the early eighties of the last century. Moreover, in 1992, he started the practice of Endoscopic Ultrasonography after he had attended the Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology of the Academic Medish Centrum in Amsterdam for a dedicated training. Up to now Prof. Napolitano has performed more than 10000 EUS procedures, 25% of which were associated with FNA or FNB. In the recent years, most of EUS procedures (about 70%) concerned the diagnosis and management of pancreatic neoplasms, both solid and cystic. Prof. Napolitano is a member of the board of the

multidisciplinary group for the study of the neuroendocrine tumors established in Naples in 2010. This group, that includes many specialists from five scientific institutions, has been acknowledged as an European Centre of Excellence by ENETS (European Society for the Study of Neuroendocrine Tumors). Prof. Napolitano is the author of more than 300 scientific papers, 60 of which available on Scopus, and of several chapters in scientific books.
