In the year 2001, he moved as Assistant Professor Medical Methodology and Semeiotic of the Faculty of Medicine of the Second University of Naples. Since 2005, he covered the position of Assistant Professor in Internal Medicine in the same Department up to 2014.

Since 2014 up to 2022 he is Associate Professor of Internal Medicine at the Second University of Naples (now University of Campania "Vanvitelli").

Since dec 2022 up to now he is **Full Professor of Internal medicine** at University of Campania "Vanvitelli", Italy.
