

CURRICULUM VITAE (english)

Daniele Solvi (Rome, 1971) is Associate Professor of Medieval and Humanistic Latin Literature at the Università della Campania "Luigi Vanvitelli" (Italy), board member of AISSCA (Associazione Italiana per lo Studio della Santità, dei Culti e dell'Agiografia, Rome), SISF (Società Internazionale di Studi Francescani, Assisi) and of the International Center for Franciscan Studies and Research. His most important research fields include philological and literary investigations about religious texts of the Late Middle Ages and their fortune in the Modern/Contemporary Age. He studied the works and medieval lives of Francis of Assisi and Bernardino of Siena, the franciscan hagiography and historiography from XIII to XV century, and other religious late-medieval texts of several genres (theology, mystic, inquisition, sermons, prophecy and eschatology). Among his main publications are the critical edition of the *Speculum perfectionis status fratrī Minoris* (Florence 2006), the 5 vols. of *La letteratura francescana* (with Claudio Leonardi and Francesco Santi, Milan 2004-2015; a sixth volume on the Spiritual Franciscans is in preparation), the 2 vols. of *Le vite quattrocentesche di Bernardino da Siena*. (Florence 2014, 2018) and the collected essays *Il mondo nuovo. L'agiografia dei Minori Osservanti* (Spoleto 2019) and *Rotundis quadrata mutare. Questioni francescane dalle origini ai Fioretti* (Spoleto 2022).
