In the last ten years, he won three awards for his researches: in 2009, the PhD research Award of the Accademia Ercolanese; in 2016, the Award for ICGG2016 during 17th International Conference on Geometry and Graphics" (China, Beijing, August 4-8, 2016) with Alessandra Avella, Nicola Pisacane, Carmine Maffei for their researches on low-cost photogrammetry techniques from airplane and UAV, with small-format cameras, and open source software; in 2018 the second prize of "PAN Landscape Architecture Nature Ardito Desio" for his research on J.M.W. Turner as topographical draughtsman.
